## DAY OF RACE

### NO SAME DAY REGISTRATIONS THIS YEAR.

**RIM2RIM:** MUST BE AT BASS LAKE BY 8:30 AM.

**1/2RIM:** MUST BE AT EAST SIDE PARKING LOT OF SPORTSMAN'S AT MAGIC VALLEY MALL BY 9:30 AM.

### TRANSPORTATION:

Due to COVID 19 there will be NO SHUTTLE BUSES to transport 1/2Rim racers back to the Sportsman parking lot. With limited racers this year there will be adequate parking at Bass Lake.

## RACE ETIQUETTE

### RUNNER VS WALKER:

**RUNNER** – Walk as necessary or run the full race.

**WALKER** – **NEVER JOG OR RUN** to be fair about your entry. One foot on the ground at all times.

### PIPELINE BRIDGE:

**WALKERS** – Yield to runners on the narrow bridge. Step aside and let them pass.

**RUNNERS** – Politely call out “RUNNER PASSING ON LEFT.”

### NO PETS OR STROLLERS ALLOWED:

Strollers block the Pipeline Bridge and are a safety hazard. Blue Lakes Country Club prohibits pets.

## RACE4HOMES



The Rim2Rim is a Magic Valley tradition! This is a 7.5 mile race that begins deep in the Snake River canyon at the prestigious Blue Lakes Country Club's Bass Lake. The course climbs out of the canyon at a treacherous 6% grade, with a Da\$h4Ca\$h prize to the first racers to make it to the top. Competitors then make their way past themed water stations lining the course, cross the amazing Perrine Bridge, pass by the Visitors Center, down the challenging 6% Canyon Springs grade, passing through the Canyon Springs Golf Course to the Pipe Line Bridge that will bring them back to the Blue Lakes Country Club and finish line at Bass Lake. Racers are greeted by Habitat volunteers and homeowners, plus served a gourmet luncheon by the Blue Lakes Country Club Chef.

The Rim2Rim is Habitat for Humanity of the Magic Valley's major community awareness and fundraising event. Habitat builds strength, stability, and self-reliance through shelter. Strong and stable homes, help build strong and stable communities.
